Fetching Album Art During Imports¶. When the plugin is enabled, it automatically tries to get album art for every album you import. By default, beets stores album art image files alongside the music files for an album in a file called cover.jpg.To customize the name of this file, use the art\_filename config option. To embed the art into the files' tags, use the EmbedArt Plugin.
